## (Getting started...)

## Suggested Introductory Lessons/Concepts:

(Any of the following lessons can be revisited at the start of each class.)

**Intro Lesson 1:** In order to teach/learn Spanish, it is a good idea to first familiarize yourself with where (in the world) Spanish is spoken, and proper Spanish Pronunciation.

**Print-out:** IL1\_Spanish Speaking Countries\_Worksheet (1 Page) (blk&wt)  
IL1\_Spanish Pronunciation (1 Page) (blk&wt).

**Intro Lesson 2:** Using a "Spanish speaking puppet", begin each class with Common Pleasantries.

**Intro Lesson 3:** Introduce vocabulary for Parts of the Body. Play "Simon Says" ("Simon Dice").

**Intro Lesson 4:** Use the Suggested Books to discuss and learn vocabulary re: Weather & Feelings.  
How is it outside? How do I feel (inside)?
